Product Overview:

Sightline™ is used to control woody and herbaceous broadleaf weeds such as buckthorn, ailanthus, hazel, and kudzu. It is rain fast within two hours and unwanted plant growth can be controlled within 1 – 2 weeks. Sightline™ is perfect for use in woodlots and natural areas for management of invasive understory vegetation and can be applied as both a foliar spray and a paint-on stump treatment.

How do I apply it?

Dilute Sightline™ in water or oil and apply as a foliar or bark spray using hand or power-operated application equipment (such as portable pump-up or backpack sprayer), or paint directly onto the plant using a paint brush.

When do I apply it?

Applications of Sightline™ can be made throughout the year, however, application methods may vary each season.

How much product do I need?

It is important to apply the proper dose to the plant you are treating. Gather the following information to determine the accurate amount of product needed:

1. Determine the plant to be treated and use the species list to verify any application specifications. If you're unsure of the best application method, please contact the Tree Geek for more information.
2. Use the rate chart to determine the total dosage for the plant to be treated. Note for foliar spray: Sightline™ is applied as a spray-to-drip application, ensuring the foliage and canopy is thoroughly covered.

Foliar Spray	Growing Season	.75 – 4.4 fluid ounces in 2 gallons of water
Foliar Spray	Dormant Season	Mix 1 part Sightline™ with 1 part oil
Bark Spray	Growing Season	20.48 – 25.6 fluid ounces in 1 gallon of water
Bark Spray	Dormant Season	Mix 1 part Sightline™ with 1 part oil
Paint-on	After plant removal	1 -1.5 quarts (32 – 48 fluid ounces) of Sightline™ per 1 gallon of water
